A Summer Program for Authentic Christian Living



INTRODUCTION

In a world where teenagers feel unprecedented pressure to blend in, the Chameleon Project offers a transformative 8-week summer experience that challenges students to discover and embrace their God-given identity. Drawing from the metaphor of a chameleon—an animal that changes its appearance to match its surroundings—this program equips teenagers to resist the temptation to "change colors" based on peer pressure, social media influence, or cultural expectations.

The foundational message is simple yet powerful: **"God created you to STAND OUT, not to BLEND IN."**

WHY THE CHAMELEON PROJECT?

 5. **MAIN CHARACTER ENERGY:** Finding Your Identity in Christ *Embracing your role in God's story rather than supporting roles in others' stories*
 6. **NO CAP:** Dating Different in a Hookup Culture *Establishing healthy boundaries and God-honoring relationships*
 7. **SQUAD GOALS:** Choosing Your Circle Wisely *Building friendships that sharpen rather than shape your identity*
